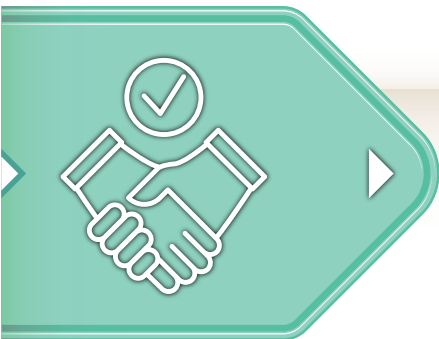

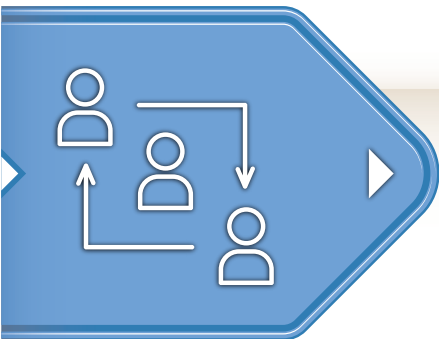
Create a designated learning environment in your home, and approach a day in virtual school with the same preparation as you would for a day in a school building.

>>> Privacy and Security

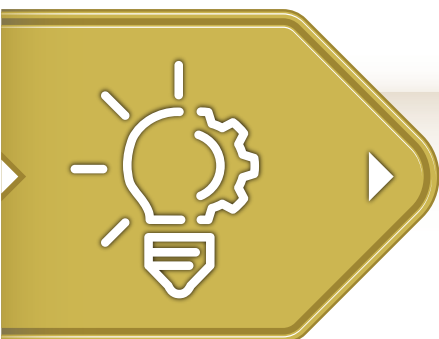
